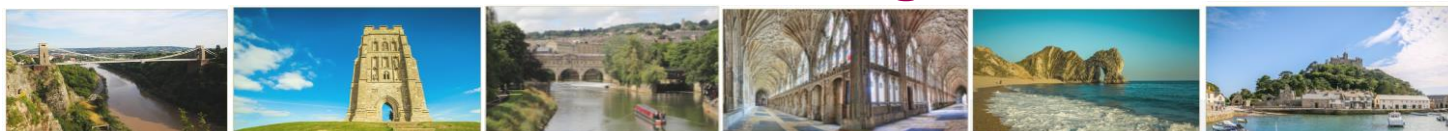


# Nursing Associate Community of Practice
